THUY BUI BURSARY EXCELLENCE IN MATH GRADE 10

In tribute to Thuy Bui, a dedicated teacher and exceptional woman, the Vanguard Foundation is proud to present the Thuy Bui Bursary. This bursary recognizes Vanguard students in grade 10 who have distinguished themselves through excellence in mathematics, despite the challenges associated with learning disabilities.







Thuy Bui was born in Hanoi in 1947 and immigrated to Canada in 1965 on a Colombo Plan scholarship. She studied chemistry at the University of Ottawa, then at York University, where she completed a master's degree. She then devoted 35 years to teaching chemistry at the college level, mainly at Vanier and Dawson College, impressing generations of students with her passion, intellectual rigor and profound benevolence.

A woman of science and of the heart, Thuy knew how to combine academic rigor with human warmth. She firmly believed that everyone deserves a chance, regardless of their starting point, and saw education as a powerful lever for emancipation, especially for those facing major challenges. Many of his former students, now doctors, researchers, journalists or leaders in the field of artificial intelligence, owe part of their career to him.

As the mother of Dan, a former student of Vanguard School, Thuy was deeply grateful to the school for the support it offered her son. Her legacy lives on today through all those she touched - her students, friends, colleagues, family - and now, Vanguard students, thanks to the scholarship that bears her name.






Each year, two bursaries are awarded:
